Hi, I checked and the service had "troubles" again.

It's working again (I've tested all functionalities from species selection to new map visualization) however please note these known issues in the portlet:

- Opening of gis-viewer is faulty (will be fixed in next release)
- Recalculate envelope is faulty (will be fixed in next release)
- Rendering of customization section may be faulty
- Grids do not display content when first rendered
- Maps static images are displayed only after resizing
- · Grids column resizing may be faulty

These are due to an obsolete framework which the portlet relies on. A migration will be provided in future releases.
