<b>Description</b> We tried to upload file bigger than 500MB, but we got the exception "Stream ended unexpectedly". It seems like the stream has been closed after a certain amount of time. We have tried to upload files through a simple Workspace portal without nginx and HProxy and it works, so the issue cannot be related to Storage or Jackrabbit. We got the same exception using Development, Production and Pre-Production portals.

I think I've found the culprit.  
When I increase the server timeout option in the haproxy configuration I'm able to upload bigger files.  
I increased the vaule of that option to 7200 seconds (2 hours).

Can you check if it works for you all? I was able to upload a 750MB file, I'm trying to upload a 4GB one right now.
